Dear Neighbor,

We had no choice.

When practically overnight, COVID-19 shut down all that we knew, when dedicated workers were abruptly unemployed, and when parents skipped meals to feed their children now unexpectedly home from school – we had no choice but to remain open. The decision to close was always possible but the choice was never one in our hearts.

Keeping Neighbor to Neighbor open during a global pandemic was no easy task yet our decision was clear. After panic buying left store shelves empty, we were here to give a worried father diapers for his newborn. When a widowed 98 year old feared leaving his home, we were here to deliver his groceries. And we were here to comfort the young woman who phoned us from her car that was now her home, desperate to know where to turn.

We would not close our doors on our neighbors.

It is hard to reflect on this past year of work without COVID-19 taking center stage. Its swift and ruthless spread across Fairfield County and our country left record numbers facing financial crisis, some for the first time in their lives. The glaring priority for so many was never rent, utilities or car payments – it was the hunger of a child, an elderly parent, or a pregnant wife. It was knowing the pain of skipped meals and worry about their next. This was why cars lined up across the nation at food banks and pantries. This was why the number of Neighbor clients nearly doubled in a few short weeks.

With your help, we were able to put nutritious food on the plates of thousands during a time when the need was critical. With your help, we were able to fulfill basic needs and other household staples when supply chains collapsed. Neighbors rallied to the rescue, offering a network of support unlike any we've ever seen. Community partners became collaborators, for-profit businesses became non-profit allies, volunteers and donors became our lifeline. Together, we showed strength beyond measure. We leaned on and lifted one another with boundless selflessness and resilience. And we continue to do this, every single day.

There is no doubt – we are Neighbor Strong.

As you read through our 2019/20 Annual Report to the Community, we hope that these pages capture and reflect the relentless will of our community to help each other overcome.

Thank you for being such a powerful force in our work and our community.

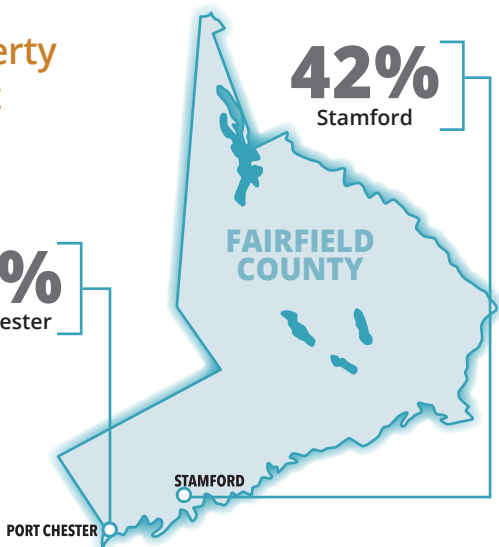
The Need is *Stronger* Than Ever. Here's why:

Food Insecurity is **RISING**

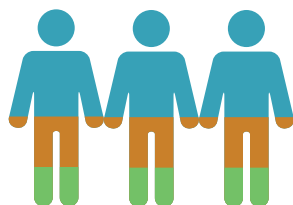


In Fairfield County, about **93,270 PEOPLE** were considered **food insecure** before the pandemic, according to Feeding America's "Map the Meal Gap".

20% of CT adults report that **at least one member of their household has lost their job or been laid off** because of the economic fallout from the pandemic.

Another **29%** of CT adults have had their **work hours cut** or been placed on temporary furlough.

By the close of our fiscal year, CT had received **635,900 unemployment claims**.









Fairfield County's unemployment rate reached a **record high** in July, from **3.4% to 10.5%**.

OUR CLOTHING ROOM:

Standing *Strong* on the Sidelines

One of the most difficult decisions we had to make once COVID-19 struck was the temporary closure of our Clothing Room due to health and safety concerns. We declined donations of clothing, shoes and home essentials – all gifted from the charitable hearts of so many neighbors. We look forward to welcoming your generosity again in the future.

Before the closure, our dedicated team of Clothing Room volunteers successfully led seasonal initiatives that brought joy to many families:

	Distributed 14,532 bags of clothing to individuals and families
	Gifted 500 students with backpacks filled with school supplies for their 2019 school year
	Welcomed parents of 500 children to shop at no cost at our annual Holiday Toy Chest for their holiday gifts
	Gave 100 families their own tree to take home at our 1st ever Christmas Tree Drive
	Distributed new towels, sheets & blankets to over 1,000 families
	Dispersed hundreds of packs of diapers and baby care items, including 32 baby layettes , to families with newborns and toddlers
	Delivered 14,944 undergarments donated by the Undies Project to families
	Provided 140 children with new winter coats

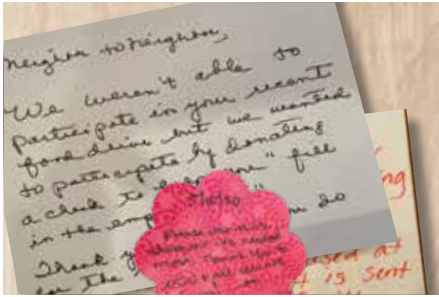

Stronger TOGETHER

Transportation Association of Greenwich, Greenwich Department of Human Services & Arch Street Teen Center

Closing our doors was never an option. However, remaining open would have been nearly impossible without the support of the dream team in community work: Transportation Association of Greenwich, Greenwich Department of Human Services and Arch Street Teen Center. Each brought years of experience, essential resources and passion to ensure our neighbors could be served with the quality and care they deserved.



Transportation Association of Greenwich:

When our food pantry could no longer allow clients access due to space and COVID-19 guidelines, we knew delivery was the best option, especially for our elderly clients, single parents and those with disabilities. That meant our weekly deliveries jumped from around 50 to over 500 – a feat that required more than our resources. TAG brought decades of valuable know-how to this part of our operations as we added hundreds of new homes to their routes. We're pretty sure that TAG drivers are superheroes in disguise – delivering through heat waves and pouring rain, all with a smile under their masks – we just haven't found where they hide their capes!

Greenwich Department of Human Services:

The Greenwich Department of Human Services has threaded our collective efforts through their coordination of client referrals for food assistance. In addition to providing direct services to clients during the crisis, they helped us manage our own dramatic uptick in clients within a matter of days. We are proud to serve as an integral part of their continuum of care by meeting the basic needs of families throughout our town.

Arch Street Teen Center:

With in-person programming practically shutdown, the Arch Street Teen Center could have closed its doors. Instead, they sought out ways to support the community's greatest needs and graciously offered to foster Neighbor to Neighbor's food pantry so that we could meet the urgent need to keep families fed and healthy. Their abundant space and open layout continues to serve as the perfect home for our staff and volunteers to safely work together each day. We appreciate their hospitality and look forward to a full calendar of events when they are able to open their doors again in the future.

Our gratitude to these community partners is immeasurable. Without hesitation, each partner committed and was ready to serve our neighbors in need. We look forward to our continued work and thank you for all you do – together we truly are stronger!
