She and her husband moved to Greenwich, where a social worker put her in touch with Neighbor. At the time, Maria and her husband were struggling to make ends meet, and worried about their young child, 6-year old Elmer, who wasn't feeling well.



After many tests run at Yale New Haven Hospital, they found out that their only child had brain cancer and at most, had a year of life remaining.

The Greenwich community, true to form, came together and planned special events for Elmer. The Greenwich Police Department hosted a Christmas party to give him toys. Neighbor to Neighbor provided special foods that Elmer liked and helped make his Thanksgiving and Christmas extra special. Maria shared that all of that made him very happy.

Sadly, Elmer passed away on May 4, 2021.

Maria and her husband are thankful and feel blessed that they can come to Neighbor to Neighbor for food every week, particularly for eggs and milk. She likes seeing and talking with all the volunteers and staff, especially Jane at the reception desk, saying they are so nice and helpful to her.
